ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND
PERMITTING COMMERCIAL
MEDICAL MARIHUANA FACILITIES
ORDINANCE NO. 91

Section I. Purpose.

This Ordinance is intended to promote the public health, safety and welfare and to safeguard the health, comfort, living conditions, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City by implementing the provisions of the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act, Public Act 281 of 2016 (MMFLA), and establishing fair and equitable rules and regulations for establishing and operating Commercial Medical Marihuana Facilities in the City consistent with Michigan law; and to help defray administrative and enforcement costs associated with the operation of marijuana facilities in the City through the imposition of annual, nonrefundable application, licensing and inspection fees on each Commercial Medical Marihuana Facility Licensee and Permit Holder. Nothing in this Ordinance is intended to grant immunity from criminal or civil prosecution, penalty or sanction for the cultivation, manufacturing, possession, use sale or distribution of marihuana, in any form, that is not in compliance with applicable Michigan laws, including but not limited to the Michigan Medical Marihuana Act, MCL 333.26421 et seq. ("MMMA") and Medical Marijuana Facilities Licensing Act, MCL 333.27101 et seq. ("MMFLA"). As of the effective date of this Ordinance, marihuana remains classified as a Schedule 1 controlled substance under the Federal Controlled Substances Act, 21 U.S.C. Sec 801 et seq., which makes it unlawful to manufacture, distribute or dispense marihuana. Nothing in this Ordinance is intended to grant immunity from criminal prosecution under applicable federal laws.
